Founded in 1849, Joseph Holt has remained in the family for over five generations. Based in Manchester, the company owns over 100 pubs and food houses in the North West and supplies Holt's beers to over 190 venues nationally.

Joseph Holt has a fine tradition for brewing quality beers and over the many years of trading the brewery has expanded its portfolio of products. Today, as well as its pubs, Holt supplies premium bottled ales to all major multiples in the UK including Sainsbury's, Tesco, Asda, Morrisons and Waitrose.

Although ever expanding and not afraid to try something new, in the entire history of Holt's Brewery, it has never changed its most successful formula – a quality pint at an affordable price.

Manchester Brown Ale

- 3.8% ABV
- A traditional English Brown Ale
- Dark brown in colour
- Brewed with a blend of roasted malt with a hint of molasses to give a smooth burnt palate with a satisfying aftertaste.



HumDinger

- 4.1% ABV
- Winner of The Tesco Beer Challenge
- Golden brown in colour
- Brewed with a combination of English malt, Mexican aroma honey and citrus flavoured hops.



1849

- 4.5% ABV
- Winner of The Gold Medal at The International Brewing Awards
- Dark brown in colour
- Brewed with a complex blend of choice coloured malts and English Ale Malt, balanced by invert sugar and golding hops.



Maple Moon

- 4.8% ABV
- Winner of The Silver Medal at The International Brewing Awards
- Golden brown in colour
- Uniquely brewed with Canadian maple syrup, combined with Amber and English Ale Malts and finished with delicate cascade American hops.



Thunder Holt

- 5.0% ABV
- A traditional Red Russet Ale with a distinctive ruby polish
- Dark copper in colour
- Brewed using the light citrus flavours of challenger cone hops and rich undertones of dark crystal malt.



Fifth Sense

- 5.5% ABV
- Light refreshing premium Ale
- Golden amber in colour
- Brewed with Styrian hops and amber malts, the intense flavour is complemented by a citrus after taste.



Sixex

- 6.0% ABV
- A traditional Winter Ale
- Very dark brown in colour
- Brewed with rich crystal and black malts to give a very distinctive roasted flavour.



Bitter

- 4.0% ABV
- Available in 500ml cans
- Brown in colour
- A full drinking bitter rich in coloured malt flavours complemented by bitterness derived from bitter and aroma whole hop cones.
